The joint council reviewed the merger details of the Ackley and Eldora EMS service. They will run under one name, Greenbelt EMS. Starting February 1, Eldora EMS will be dual paged with Ackley EMS.

Each City will maintain their own EMS building. The financial splitting of the new service will need more review and a sub-committee will be formed. They discussed the benefits of the combine service, full coverage 24/7, paramedic services and expanded services. There will also be an Advisory Board consisting of the EMS Director, two crew members (one from each City) and four community members with two from each community school district. The

The sub-committee to review the how the financial splitting will be done will be Carey Morton, Jerry Kramer and Maile Carter from Eldora and Judy Crawford, Dan Scallon and Joan Frazier from Ackley. The first meeting will be February 1 at 6:30 at the Ackley EMS.

6:30 at the Ackley EMS. Scott Williams from Steamboal Rock was inquiring if Ackley and Eldora both had a call at the same time, who would cover Steamboal Rock. Maile said they run a three rig system and if Steamboat Rock EMS could not cover, the third Eldora rig could.
