NOTICE OF ELDORA-NEW PROVIDENCE SCHOOL SPECIAL ELECTION

September 13, 2022

Notice is hereby given to the qualified voters of Hardin County, Iowa that the Eldora-New Providence Community School District has requested a special election on Tuesday, September 13, 2022. The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Voters are hereby notified that the polling place for voters in Hardin County will be at the Hardin County Courthouse.

A public test of the vote tabulating equipment will be conducted at the Emergency Management Building beginning at 9:00 a.m. on September 9, 2022 and continuing until completion of the required test.

In-person Absentee voting is available at the courthouse, Monday thru Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. thru Monday, September 12, 2022.

Hardin County residents who are not registered to vote are encouraged to do so. With the proper identification, residents may register on election day at the precinct where the person is voting.

Voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered or who have changed precincts are also required to provide proof of residence.

Any voter who cannot show ID may: 1) have voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct; 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents; or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the County Auditor's office by September 15, 2022. Voter Accessibility: All voting

sites are fully accessible to persons with physical disabilities. Voters may also choose another person to assist them to vote, except their employer, employer's agent, or an officer or agent of the voter's union.

Any voter who is physically unable to enter a polling place has the right to vote in the voter's vehicle.

Eldora-New Providence Community School District Proposition "JN"

Shall the Board of Directors of the Eldora-New Providence Community School District in the Counties of Hardin, Grundy, and Marshall, State of Iowa, be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$9,900,000 to provide funds to be used together with sales tax bond proceeds and general obligation capital loan note proceeds, secured by the physical plant and equipment levy, to provide funds to build, furnish, and equip additions to District facilities, including an addition to the elementary facility which will include gymnasium, media center, preschool and office space, with related site improvements, including a new access drive and additional parking; and to remodel, renovate, improve, furnish, and equip existing facilities, including the elementary facility and the career and technical education space at the high school facility?
